- **Dementia Live**—A 45-minute learning experience for caregivers assisting those with any form of Dementia. Participants use goggles, headphones, and other tools to experience a dementia state.

- **Stress Busting for Family Caregivers**—Nine evidence-based sessions lasting 1.5 hours each. Caregivers learn eight stress management techniques and receive a manual.
