The Resolution contemplates that Salt Lake County will receive \$320,000 through a separate Funding Memorandum of Agreement (also attached) for the sole purpose of supporting the Cottonwood Connect Ski Shuttle Program managed by Visit Salt Lake for the 2023-2024 Ski Season (December 22, 2023 - April 14, 2024). The Grant Agreement provides for transferring the intended Cottonwood Connect funds received by Salt Lake County from UTA to VSL within 45 days after the execution of the Grant Agreement to provide for public transit service through Big and Little Cottonwood Canyons. The Grant Agreement and Resolution are subject to the approval of the County Council</p>

The applicant, Adam Von Maack, is applying on behalf of the owner of the property. The owner wishes to subdivide the property located at 3198 North 2200 West into two separate lots in order to sell the home on the back portion of the lot while keeping the barn. The current property is 1.47 acres in size, but the A-2 zone requires a minimum lot size of 1 acre which would prevent the property from being subdivided. The A-1 zone that the applicant desires would reduce the required lot size to 10,000 square feet and allow for a subdivision</p>
