Happy World Refugee Day! As many of you may know, here at Salt Lake County, we are committed to helping refugees find a safe place to live. In fact, Salt Lake County was the first county in the nation to achieve the Certified Welcoming designation back in 2018, emphasizing our unwavering commitment to supporting immigrants and refugees.

Cities and counties are Certified Welcoming because they have implemented policies and programs reflecting their dedication to immigrant inclusion. By meeting the strict requirements of the Welcoming Standard, Salt Lake County has demonstrated its efforts to embrace and welcome immigrants in all aspects of civic, social, and economic life within our communities.

Salt Lake County's commitment to welcoming is exemplified by the development of its Countywide Language Access Plan, which aims to expand equitable access to programs, services, and activities in the languages that are spoken by community members. In the same vein, the Council on Diversity Affairs (CODA) serves as a forum for promoting an inclusive community and government through dialogue, respect, and action. CODA fosters an inclusive environment through dialogue, respect, and action, where everyone's voice is heard and valued.

Additionally, earlier this month, a Refugee Fair was hosted in partnership with Mayor Jenny Wilson, Chair Amy Winder Newton, New American Liaison Joseph Genda, and community members to successfully distribute emergency kits and resources to over 25 Afghan refugee families.

**Center** (1355 W 3100 S, West Valley City, UT 84119)! Here are a few quick reminders for those of you who are attending:

- Remember your ID badge: Employee identification badges will be required to check-in at the Welcome Booths to receive a meal ticket. If you do not have a employee ID badge, staff will cross-check your name with the RSVP list.
- Use public transit or carpool: Parking is extremely limited so if you plan to attend Employee Appreciation Day alone, we recommend:
- 1. Taking the UTA MAX bus line at the stop located on 3300 S @ 1226 W and walking (.5 mile distance).
- Riding UTA's TRAX light rail system is one mile from the Utah Cultural Celebration Center via the Green Line's Decker Lake Station, if you don't mind a slightly longer walk (1 mile distance).
- Carpooling and using one of the 2 designated lots or, if those lots are full, parking at the Veterans Memorial Park (.1 mile distance) or Redwood Recreation Center (.4 mile distance).
- Attending at an off time: If you are concerned about lines and parking, consider coming before or after the lunch rush. Food trucks will be at Employee Appreciation Day for the entire event (11 a.m.-4 p.m.).

### What to Expect: Adobe Licensing Changes

In preparation for Adobe licensing changes at the end of the month, we have begun the process to remove the current 32 bit version of Adobe Acrobat and replace it with the 64 bit version month. This process will happen in two phases (<u>Learn more / see dept. deployment schedule</u>).

**Important!** The Thursday prior to a department's scheduled deployment, an email will be sent to the <u>department IT contacts/liaisons</u> with information about the deployment. This information can then be shared internally so users know exactly what to expect.
