
At this year's <u>Employee Appreciation Day</u>, we will be enjoying food from 5 different food trucks to give our employees a diverse selection of options. Here's a quick explanation on how the process will work:

- 1. Employees will check in at one of the two check-in booths at the venue. (One in the front lobby and one on the rotunda.)
- 2. To speed up the check-in process, employee badges or other employment identification will be validated.
- 3. Once checked in, all employees will receive a food voucher, along with this year's Bingo card.

Vouchers are good for one free meal at any of the food trucks at the event. (But if employees would like additional food, they can purchase more directly at the food trucks.) And the best part? The food trucks will be at the Utah Cultural Celebration Center for the entire event! If you want to avoid a line, we recommend coming before or after peak lunch hours.

And now the moment you've all been waiting for: an introduction to our food trucks! The Salty Pineapple, Where's Aldo? Taqueria, Marquesas Corn Dogs, the Cluck Truck, and Liv Pure Acai will all be joining us for a fantastic event! Tech Outages Webex Space

We're Trying Something New: SLCo - Tech Outages Webex Space

In the spirit of continual process improvement, we are trying something new.

What?

- We have created a new "SLCo-Tech Outages" Webex space.
- This is an announcement only space—which means only IT moderators can post to the space. (So don't throw your keyboard if you can't type in this space, it is intended that way.)

Space purpose: Very specific.

Timely communication channel for IT staff (assigned as moderators) to communicate known IT Outages that have, or potentially have, broad county impact.

Why?

We have heard from some of our partners that it is hard to keep up with all the dialogue in the "SLCo-Tech Talk" Webex space, as important outage information can often get lost in the mix of other things...so we wanted to see if there was a more efficient way for us to share timely outage information with both our technical and non-technical users that wouldn't get lost in the conversation.

Important: The current <u>SLCo-Tech Talk space</u> will remain the place for 2-way dialogue and the place where you can post/alert us to possible widespread outages, ask questions, etc. After posting in the Outages space, we will monitor the Tech Talk space for follow-up questions.

Outlook App for County Emails

Do you access your County email on your phone? If so, now's the time to install and configure the Outlook app if you haven't already.

Toward the end of the month, Office 365 will be moved to the <u>new ePortal</u>, and multifactor authentication will be enabled to improve security. After these changes are made, you will need to use the Outlook app to access your County email on a phone.

Instructions for installing the Outlook app on your mobile device can be found <u>here</u> (and vary depending on if you are using an Android or Apple device).

Once this change is in effect, employees will need to use the Outlook app for their County email and a separate app (the phone's built-in mail app or another app, like Gmail) for accessing personal email accounts. (Note: You can add both Gmail and non-Gmail accounts to the Gmail app.)
