An out-of-state deferral from the emissions inspection requires:

- This form, completed in full; failure to provide **ALL** information will result in delay or denial of deferral.
- Verification of vehicle location outside the State of Utah.

If we grant a deferral, you will receive a follow-up email with instructions to complete your vehicle registration.

Select vehicle location from the drop-down menu and click Generate State Report button Scroll down to Contact Information section and contact the program for instructions to obtain an emissions inspection certificate   If your vehicle cannot be emissions inspected by a local emissions inspection program or there is no program where your vehicle is located, you must follow instructions in Option 2.   Option 2: Submit a VIN Verification Form Completed by an Official Where the Vehicle is Located   If there is no emissions inspection program available where your vehicle is located, you must provide documentation of the vehicle's location by submitting a completed VIN Verification Form from a local law enforcement, motor vehicle department, or (if applicable) university/campus or military base law enforcement officer. The form must be signed by the officer. If the local official does not provide a VIN Verification Form, use the VIN Verification Form on the next page.				

Submit this completed form, along with either the vehicle's emission certificate (from Option 1) or the completed VIN Verification Form (Option 2), to the mailing or email address at the top of the form.



Must be completed by a duly constituted federal, state, county, city, or campus law enforcement or military officer—IF a valid, current emission test is not available.
