Overview of Boards and Commissions

- What They Are: Advisory and policy boards that help shape county policies and programs.
- Why They Matter: Provide community voices in decision-making, ensuring diverse perspectives are considered.
- Who Can Serve: County residents from all backgrounds; no prior government experience required.
- **Examples of Boards:** Board of Health, Animal Services Advisory Council, Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, etc.
