Providing Public Health Services

- Immunizations
- Nutrition assistance (WIC) for lower income families
- Home visiting for lower income families
- Vital records (birth and death certificates)



Can't assist with:

- Individual medical care

Maintaining Housing Standards

- Chemical (meth) contamination
- Lack of heat, electricity, water, hot water, sewer or septic connection
- Active water leak (roof or plumbing)
- Pest infestation (rodent, cockroach, bedbug)
- Mosquito harborage
- Hoarding (if a toilet is not accessible)
- Wood burning on an air action day



Can't respond to:

- Lack of air conditioning
- Mold (unless due to active water leak)
- Evictions/Lease termination

Educating Businesses

- Food safety in restaurants or at food trucks/carts
- Mass gatherings/special events
- Swimming pool/spa concerns
- Public lodging
- Body art (tattoo, piercing)
- Cosmetology
- Tanning
- Massage
- Vehicle emissions stations
- Tobacco retailers and smoking/vaping in a business



Can't respond to:

- Food manufacturing (bakeries, butchers, dairies): UDAF
- Grocery stores (except deli food service): UDAF
- Medical offices/hospitals/care facilities: UDHHS
