**JMI CJAC Assessment**

Justice Management Institute (JMI) presented preliminary findings from the CJAC assessment. The presentation summarized stakeholder interviews and survey responses collected during the assessment process. JMI will incorporate stakeholder feedback before releasing the final report.

*Emerging themes included:*

- Strong support for CJAC's collaborative structure.
- Opportunities to strengthen accountability, communication, and implementation of committee recommendations.
- Desire for clearer action plans following committee discussions.
- Interest in improved tracking of initiatives and measurable outcomes.

*Members discussed:*

- Developing clearer implementation strategies.
- Establishing ongoing progress tracking.
- Organizing recommendations by responsible jurisdiction (state, county, municipal, etc.).
- Creating mechanisms to regularly revisit priorities and monitor progress.

**Utah Department of Corrections – The ARCH Framework**

Utah Department of Corrections Deputy Commissioner Rebecca Brown, And Nick Bricker with the Community Safety and Stability Bureau presented on The ARCH Project Status and Framework.

Highlights:

- The Department's increased involvement in earlier intervention within the Sequential Intercept Model.
- Implementation of new legislative authority supporting individuals who are high utilizers of multiple public systems.
- Building stronger partnerships across behavioral health, homelessness, criminal justice, and community organizations.
- Using data and cross-system collaboration to improve long-term outcomes and reduce repeated system involvement.
- Expansion of community-based initiatives, including Project Rio, Project Connect, and ARCH-related efforts.
- Continued collaboration with the Office of Homeless Services and other state partners.
