School Based Concerns for SLCo Youth

Alex Allen highlighted the importance of addressing youth within CJAC and proposed a new CJAC Workgroup focusing on youth issues in the criminal justice system. Executive Director at Utah Juvenile Defender Attorneys, Pamela Vickery, discussed what schools are seeing and problems they are addressing. This included juvenile justice referrals, school-based offences (assault, drug, trespassing etc.), weapon and firearm offences. Current legislation aimed at and supporting schools and youth involved in the criminal justice system was reviewed.

The focus will be officers utilizing the receiving center more and finding grant/funding opportunities that can support crisis calls in the community to help relieve workload.

Reentry & Reintegration: Amy Stocks gave an update that the group will focus on mapping out current reentry landscape, utilizing the jail dashboard, and improving upon ID process. Also informed the group of the recent Reentry Reintegration Simulation event.
