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### PROPERTY TAXES

Property owners pay property tax to taxing entities such as counties, cities, school districts and special service districts that provide public services.

$$\text{Taxable Value} \times \text{Tax Rate} = \text{Property Tax}$$

Each year, your property tax is calculated by multiplying the taxable value of your property by that year's tax rate for each taxing entity.

Each year, both the taxable value and the tax rate will change. This document notifies you of the calculation of your property tax this year and what you may do if you disagree.

If a taxing entity is not increasing its tax rate you may still participate in public hearings regarding its budget. You may also contact the people who are elected or appointed to set the budget and tax rate for the taxing entity.

Tax Increase: If a taxing entity intends to increase its tax rate this year, you are given notice and may participate in the public meeting. The date, time, and place of each public hearing is listed on the front of this form.

### RIGHT TO APPEAL

If you believe that the assessed market value of your property is incorrect, you may appeal to the County Board of Equalization by filing an Appeal Form with the Salt Lake County Auditor as Clerk of the Board of Equalization at 2001 S. State Street, N3-300, PO Box 144575, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4575.

**Deadline to file is 09/16/2024.**

These instructions and deadline do not apply to property assessed by the Utah State Tax Commission.
