WE will not have a market on Easter Sunday, April 5. Please note that this form is an APPLICATION, and does not guarantee your acceptance into the Winter Market. Vendors are not required to participate in all dates of the market. Please mark which dates you are available on page 2. You may be chosen for all or some of your chosen dates. All applicants will be required to pay the 2026 yearly application fee (\$35). Once you have submitted your application, you will receive instructions to pay this fee. Applications will close December 1, and all vendors will be notified if they have been accepted by December 12.

Food and Drink applications are responsible for securing the necessary permits from the health department. Food/drink trucks must send a copy of their permit from their local health department with application. Food/drink booths must have a temporary food service permit with the SLCO health department. Pre-packaged food vendors must also be permitted with the appropriate permit. Please note that we are unable to accommodate vendors operating under the HB-181 (Homemade Food Act) at the Winter Market due to limited space. Vendors operating under the Cottage Food Law are welcome, but must be appropriately inspected and labeled.

The Winter Market operates from 9am-1pm. Vendors are expected to stay for the entire time frame. Vendors are responsible for set up and clean up of their booth space.

Market Fees:

- All vendors must pay the non-refundable \$35 application fee once per year. Once you have paid this fee, you will be able to apply to all 2026 events at Wheeler Farm without incurring additional costs.
- If accepted into the market, vendors will be charged \$15/market day for growers/producers, \$17/market day for processed/packaged food, and \$35/day for arts and crafts vendors and food trucks.
